

ANNUAL AND SPECIAL MEETING FOR ROCKY MOUNTAIN LIQUOR INC

NOTICE AND ACCESS NOTIFICATION TO SHAREHOLDERS

You are receiving this notification as Rocky Mountain Liquor Inc. (“Rocky” or the “Corporation”) has decided to use the notice and access model for delivery of meeting materials to holders (“Shareholders”) of common shares of Rocky (“Common Shares”). Under notice and access, Shareholders still receive a proxy or voting instruction form enabling them to vote at the Company’s meeting. However, instead of a paper copy of the Management Information Circular certain Shareholders receive this notice with information on how they may access such materials electronically. The use of this alternative means of delivery is more environmentally friendly as it will help reduce paper use and also will reduce the cost of printing and mailing materials to Shareholders.

BUSINESS OF THE MEETING

The specific details of the matters to be brought before the Meeting are set forth in the Management Information Circular and Proxy Statement dated May 11, 2026.

Shareholders are reminded to view the Management Information Circular prior to voting.

The purposes of the Meeting are:

1. to receive the audited consolidated financial statements of the Corporation for the year ended December 31, 2025, and the report of the auditors thereon;
2. to consider, and if deemed advisable, to pass a resolution electing the directors of the Corporation for the ensuing year;
3. to consider, and if deemed advisable, to pass a resolution appointing PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, Chartered Professional Accountants, as auditor of the Corporation, for the ensuing year and to authorize the directors to fix the auditors remuneration;
4. to consider, and if deemed advisable, to pass an ordinary resolution to ratify and approve the Corporation’s Stock Option Plan, as more particularly described in the Information Circular; and
5. to transact such other business as may properly come before the Meeting or any adjournment or adjournments thereof.

THE RIGHT TO VOTE

Holders of Common Shares as at the close of business on May 6, 2026, are entitled to receive notice of and to attend and vote at the Meeting, or any adjournment or postponement of the Meeting.

STRATIFICATION

Rocky has determined that all registered shareholders will receive a paper copy of the Information Circular and Annual Statements, whereas beneficial shareholders will only receive this notice and a voting instruction form or proxy form.

The process of sending this notification to beneficial Shareholders without standing instructions and the Management Information Circular to registered Shareholders and to beneficial Shareholders with standing instructions to receive

a paper copy thereof is known as “stratification” and is permitted under the rules of “notice and access.” If your Common Shares are registered in the name of a nominee (usually a trust company, securities broker or other financial institution), you are a beneficial Shareholder. If your Common Shares are registered in your name you are a registered Shareholder.

REGISTERED SHAREHOLDERS

In order to be valid and acted upon at the Meeting, completed proxies must be received by Computershare using the below methods, by 8:00 a.m. (MST) on Thursday, June 18, 2026, or, in the case of any adjournment or postponement of the Meeting, at least 48 hours (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays) prior to the time of the adjourned or postponed Meeting. A person appointed as a proxyholder need not be a Shareholder. See the Information Circular for further instructions.
